

Prohibited substances

A reminder that many of the medications and supplements we use in our competition horses are banned substances, and sufficient withhold periods must be adhered to, to ensure that all treated horses return negative drug tests. The most common swab able products that we are asked about are;



- 1. Analgesics and anti-inflammatories
- 2. Ulcer medications
- 3. Antibiotics
- 4. Calming supplements (including B-group vitamins, tryptophan, sedatives)
- 5. Hormones (anabolics, Regumate ®)



We would like to emphasize that all withhold periods are to be used as a guide only, as each horse is an individual and will metabolise drugs at a different rate.
